

Tennis Court Guidelines

The tennis courts are for Hedgerose residents in good standing and their guests.

No pets (dogs, cats, etc.) are allowed on the tennis courts.

Children under 12 should be supervised by an adult – Parents will be responsible for any damages.

Hours of operation Mon – Sun 8am to 10pm. Please turn off the lights when you are finished.

The tennis courts are to be used for playing tennis only. No other games are permitted. Only non-marking tennis shoes should be worn on the courts.

All trash should be deposited in appropriate containers. Chairs from the pool area should not be placed on the tennis courts – they will damage the surface.

For reservation purposes Court 1 will be defined as the court near the clubhouse and Court 2 will be defined as the far court.

Courts can be reserved one hour for singles and one and half hours for doubles. Reservations for individual league matches (K-Swiss, T2, etc) must be noted at the time of reservation and will be limited to two hours. The league match will be allowed to finish even if play goes beyond the two hour reservation. If you reserve the time slot directly after an individual league match that court may be available earlier or later depending on the length of the league match.

When not reserved, court use is on a first-come, first-served basis. Playing time is limited to the hours set above when others are waiting to play.

A tennis court reservation system will be in place – reservations will expire if play does not begin 10 minutes after the reserved start time. Reservations should be made a minimum of 3 hours before the planned start time.

Tennis teams (Alta, USTA, etc.) may reserve both courts for practice one night (Monday – Thurs) during the week. Any additional weeknight practice will have to follow the tennis court reservation rules.

Tennis teams should be comprised of at least 50% Hedgerose residents in good standing. Any variations must be approved by the HOA Board.

Non-Resident tennis team members shall pay \$20 per calendar year if they begin play in the winter or spring. If they begin play in the summer or fall the fee is only \$10.

Tennis teams must present their roster to the Board prior to start of each season.

Tennis team captains must be Hedgerose residents in good standing.
